

Flexmls Tip!

How to Create Sub Areas with Map Overlays

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Flexmls users have the ability to create their own overlays that may be applied to searches. These overlays can be used to recreate discontinued sub areas. Or a user can create their own shapes and boundaries.

- 1. Log into Flexmls and open the Menu.
- 2. Select My Map Overlays.
- 3. Select **New** to create new overlays.

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- 4. In the top right corner of the map, select **Overlays**.
- 5. Select **MLS Areas** to apply the sub area template.



6. Locate the sub area you would like to trace.



7. Select the polygon shape on the bottom right corner of the map.



- 8. Trace over the desired sub area
- 9. Double click the last point of the drawn shape to hold the shape.



- 10. Select the created overlay.
- 11. Select edit.





12. Enter the desired name.



- 13. Repeat process as needed.
- 14. Select **Save** in the top right corner.
- 15. Enter the desired name for the category of overlays you have created.
- 16. Select Save.



Using saved overlays:

- 1. Log into Flexmls and select Quick Search.
- 2. Enter the name of the overlay in the criteria search bar.
- 3. Press ENTER on your keyboard or double click the overlay name in the pop up window.
- 4. Continue filling search criteria as needed.
